Sum of thirty pound Sterling as <sup>note</sup> a certain by the said John signed may appear  
and being so therefore Indebted the said John in Consideration thereof afterwards to  
the Day and Year aforesd at Somerset County aforesd and Within the Jurisdiction of  
this Court upon himself did assume and to the said Richard then and there faithfully  
fully promised that he the said John the said thirty pounds Sterling to the said  
Richard when he Should be thereto Required well and faithfully would pay and  
Content Never the less the said John ~~had~~ <sup>had</sup> broken his promise and assumption and  
in forme and made noe ways regarding but Designing and fraudulently Inbind  
ing the said Richard in this part to Deceive and Defraud the said thirty pounds  
Sterling or any part thereof to the said Richard hath not paid or any ways satis  
fied altho this to doe the said John afterwards to witt the same Day and  
year aforesd at Somerset County aforesd by the said Richard was Required  
but the same to him to pay or Satisfie hath hitherto altogether Refused  
and Still doth Refuse to the Damage of him the said Richard of Sixty pounds  
like Money and thened he bringe Suite --
