by the said party laid out and expended about his suit by way of attachment against the goods
chattels lights or fadits of the said John Shapleigh according to act of assembly in such case made
and provided &c.

and Twenty Nine at Somerset County upon himselfe assumed and to the
same Abraham then and there faithfully did Promise that he the same Edward
not Only so much Money as he the said Abraham Should Reasonably Desere
for the Use of the said Cart and horses would well and truly Content and Pay but
also would well and truly Retorne unto the same Abraham the Cart and
horses aforesd when therunto Required And the aforesd Abraham in his
Saith that he the said Abraham afterward to wit the Day and Year aforesd
at Somerset County aforesd did hire and Deliver unto the aforesd Edward the Cart
