Wth. William Gasit J^{ud}. } Somerset s^r. William Whittington late of Somerset County Gentleman was, attacked
L^y. William Whittington. } to answer unto William Gasit J^{ud}. of copies of the pass upon the case &c.

And whereupon the same William Gasit by William Bevingham his attorney
com^{pl}ainth that whereas the aforesaid William Whittington after the first day of May in the year of
Our Lord God seventeen hundred and five (to witt) the tenth day of May which was in the year of Our
Lord God seventeen hundred and thirty One at Somerset County aforesaid did draw his certain note in Writing
a promissary note with his proper hand subscribed bearing date the same day and year last mentioned
and that note unto the same William Gasit then and there did deliver, by which same note the same
William Whittington did promise to pay unto the same William Gasit or Order the Sum of three pound
current money of England and by reason thereof as also by force of the Statute in such case
lately made and provided the same William Whittington became L^yable to pay unto the said William
Gasit the aforesaid three pound L^yd. money according to the tenour of the note aforesaid and so being
L^yable the aforesaid William Whittington ^{Whittington} in consideration thereof afterwards to witt the tenth day
of June which was in the year of Our Lord God seventeen hundred and thirty One aforesaid at
Somerset County aforesaid upon himself did assume and unto the same William Gasit then
there faithfully did promise to pay unto William Gasit the aforesaid Sum of three pound L^yd.
money according to the tenour of the note aforesaid nevertheless the aforesaid William Whittington his
promise and assumption aforesaid not regarding but mind^{ing} and fraudulently intending the same Wth.
Gasit in this part craftily and subtilly to deceive and defraud the aforesaid Sum of three pound L^yd.
money or any part thereof unto the same William Gasit hath not paid (altho' to do the same by the
aforesaid William Gasit afterwards to witt the Eleventh day of June in the year of Our Lord God
Seventeen hundred and thirty two at the County aforesaid the aforesaid William Whittington was required)
but that unto him hitherto, to pay altogether hath refused and still doth refuse to pay the damages of the
same William Gasit of Six pound L^yd. money and thereupon he bringeth suite for
Blagge & J^{ud}goe
R^{id}ge

And the aforesaid William Whittington by Levi Gale his attorney sever and defends the force and Injury
when &c. and pray^s Leave thereof to be par^led here until next Court and he hath it and the same day is
given to the aforesaid William Gasit here also &c.

All which said next Court to witt the twenty first day of March and Dowd One thousand seven hundred
and thirty One came againe as well the aforesaid William Gasit as the aforesaid William Whittington by
their attorney aforesaid and whereupon the same William Whittington pray^s further Leave thereof
to be par^led here until next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid William
Gasit here also &c.

All which said next Court to witt the twentieth day of the June month and Dowd One thousand
seven hundred and thirty two came againe as well the aforesaid William Gasit as the aforesaid William
Whittington by their attorney aforesaid and whereupon the same William Whittington pray^s further
Leave
