Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baron of Baltimore To the Sheriff of Somerset County greeting we Commaund you that you attach any the Goods Chattels Rights or Credits of George Martin Late of Somerset County Merchant if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the Value of One thousand pounds of Tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the same in your Custody safe keep so that you have the same before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third tuesday of Novemb^r Next then and there to be condemned according to Act of Assembly to and for the Use of a certain W^m Jones Unless the said George Martin by himselfe or his Attorney shall appear and Answer unto the said W^m Jones in a plea of the said upon the Case vizt - According to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the Person or Persons in whose hands you make the same Attachment that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew Cause if any he she or they have Why the same Goods Chattels Rights or Credits so Attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to Act of Assembly in such Case made and provided ^{in a them} if to him it shall seem and how you shall Execute this writt that you make known unto our said Justices at the Day and place aforesaid and have you then and there this Writt Witness Robert King Gent Chief Justices of our said Court the Eighteenth Day of August In the Eighteenth Year of our Dominion J. Am: Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two - All which said third tuesday of Novemb^r to witt the twenty first Day of the same Month Ann: Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two being the Day of the Return of the said Writt Cometh the said W^m Jones by his Attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to Whome the foregoing writt was Directed Likewise came and made Returns thereof to the Court here Endorsed in these Words following Vizt - By Vertue of the within writt to me Directed to the Justices within Mentioned I Certifie that on the Eighteenth Day of Octob^r 1732. I have Attached in the hands of W^m Jones to the Value of Seven hundred pounds of Tobacco and I further Certifie that by John Doe and Richard Roe Lawfull men of my Bailiwick that I have made known that he be and appear at the Place and time appointed &
