 Proceedings in the said Court Remaining more plainly appears to be paid unto
 the said Charles when he should be thereunto Required Never the less the said Will:
 tho' often Required the said five pounds Eleven Shillings and four pence Current
 money of Virginia and two thousand one hundred and Nine pounds of Tobacco to
 the said Charles hath not Rendered but the same to him either to Render hath
 Denyed and still Doth Deny and Unjustly Detain to the Damage of the said

 that five pounds Eleven shillings and four pence Current money of Virginia is
 Equal in Value to Six pounds two shillings and five pence Current Money of Mary:

 when and says that he cannot gain say the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Charles Gallen, nor but that

 the said Six pounds two shillings and five pence Current Money of Maryland and two thousand one hundred
 and nine pounds of Tobacco his debt aforesaid as also three hundred and ten pounds of
 Tobacco for his damages which he sued by Omission of the detaining of that same debt to the said Charles
 of his agent by the Court here adjudged and the said William in Money &c. whereupon the said Charles by his attorney
 aforesaid hath in Court Committed to the said W^m Wye the said three hundred and ten pounds of Tobacco his damages aforesaid, this
 for the said W^m of the said three hundred and ten pounds of Tobacco damages aforesaid to be quiet &c.
