David Layfield | David Layfield (son of Robert Layfield late of Somerset County deceased) is bound  
bound to by the Court of this Court consent unto a certain John Denton until his arrival at the age of  
John Denton twenty one years, the said David Layfield being seventeen years of age last January.  
The said David Layfield to serve his said Master John Denton the full term aforesaid during which time  
the said David Layfield his said Master well and faithfully shall serve, his secrets keep, his commandments  
lawfully and honestly every where willingly shall do and in all things as good and faithfully servant shall  
demean himself towards his said Master and all his during the term aforesaid &c.

In consideration of which Service the said John Denton present before this Court covenanteth  
with the Justices of the same Court, in Court Judicially sitting, on behalf of the said David Layfield that he  
the said John Denton during the term aforesaid will teach his said apprentice the trade of a Shoemaker  
and to Read well in the Bible and at the expiration of his Servitude give him in said apprenticeship a set of the  
makers tools and a new Suit of Leather over and above his common wearing Leather and Likewise  
provide for his said apprentice meat drink washing Lodging and Clothing and all other necessary  
sufficient for such an apprentice to have and wear during the term aforesaid &c.

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court here that the aforesaid John Denton give Security  
for to comply with the covenants aforesaid &c.

Whereupon the said John Denton with John Phillips of Somerset County planter his County both  
present before Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to owe and stand justly indebted  
unto the said David Layfield in twenty pounds Sterling good and Lawfull money of England joyntly  
and severally of their body's goods or chattels Lands and tenements to be made and levied to the use  
of the said David Layfield his heirs and assigns. If it happen that the aforesaid John Denton do  
not during the term of Servitude teach his said apprentice the trade of a Shoemaker and to read  
well in the Bible, and at the expiration of his Servitude do not give him a new Suit of Leather over and above  
his common wearing Leather, and do not Likewise provide for his said apprentice meat drink washing  
Lodging and Clothing and all other necessary sufficient for such an apprentice to have and wear during  
the term aforesaid &c.

where willingly shall do, and in all things as good and faithfully servant shall demean him  
self
