vera John Donelson Foreman. - Thereupon command was given to the Just. of Somerset County that he shoud  
take of said Solomon Townsend if he to answer the same and afterwards hereat this Court holden at Dodington in Somer-  
erset County aforesaid the twentieth day of March and Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two before the  
Justices of the same Court Judicially Sitting come the aforesaid Solomon Townsend in his proper person according to afor-  
said Recoginace by him and his pledges in that part before acknowledged, and being Justly demanded how  
he would acquitt himself of the trespass and assault aforesaid as by his Indictment and above upon him Impos-  
ed sayeth that of the trespass and assault aforesaid above upon him imposed he is guilty thereof and  
himself upon the favour of the Court. whereupon all and Singular the premises by the Court had been seen  
read and fully understood - It is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Solomon Townsend  
pay unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary for a fine hereupon him imposed by reason of the trespass  
and assault aforesaid wherof in sum total he is bound two hundred pounds of tobacco and that  
the said Solomon Townsend be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine and the said Just. Joshua  
Caldwell being present here in Court took charge of the said Solomon Townsend accordingly &c —

Whereupon the said Solomon Townsend appears to his Recoginace for his good behaviour, and he and his  
Family are accordingly discharged. Whereupon the said Solomon Townsend is ordered to give new Recoginace  
for his good behaviour and appearance at June Court next. &c —

Whereupon the said Solomon Townsend with John Townsend Junr late of Somerset County planter  
his Family both present here in Court in their proper persons did acknowledge themselves to owe and stand Justly  
indebted unto his Lordships the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors in the sum of ten  
Pounds Sterling each of their goods and Chattells paid and remitted Separately to be made and levied to the  
use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors If it happen that the said Solomon Townsend do not make  
his personal appearance before the Justices of his said Lordships County Court of Somerset to be holden at Dodington  
Crest the third Tuesday of June next and do not stand and abide his Judgment, and do not in the mean time  
be of the good behaviour towards his said Lordship and all other the people of his Province &c — Then this  
Court to have fine by otherwise done.
