by reason of the trespass and assault aforesaid whereof he aforesaid he is bound one hundred  
pounds of tobacco and that the said James Townsend be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine  
aforesaid the Sher. of Somerset County to witness Joshua Fieldwell gent present here in Court took charge of the  
said James Townsend accordingly he. —
