

truth of and upon the premises being elected tried and sworn and forasmuch as it did appear ^{whether his said Lordship with the help of} well
to the Justice of the Peace, as to the said Robert Denton's Henry, upon evidence that the said Richard Dinkell had
committed a robbery upon a certain James Shirley &c. ^{whereupon} Thomas Deal one of the Jurors aforesaid
Impannelled, and sworn, by the Command of the Justices aforesaid (and of the Consent of the said Robert
Denton's Henry, who in this part prosecutes) is withdrawn and the Rest of the same Jurors sworn of their
Verdict of and upon the premises, aforesaid to be done, are fully discharged &c.

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court that the aforesaid Richard Dinkell give Security for his good-
behaviour, and appearance before his Lordship's Justice of the Peace, nisi proin, oyer &
Terminer and Goal deliver ^{to be} held at Dwidning Creek in Somerset County the first Tuesday of Aprile
next to answer unto his Lordship of and concerning the Robbery aforesaid. But for want here
of the said Richard Dinkell is committed into the Custody of the Sher. Somerset County there to Remain till
the said Sher. to witt Joshua Caldwell Gent present herein Court took Charge of said Richard Dinkell
accordingly &c.

Likewise it is ordered by the Court ^{here} that James Shirley of Somerset County
Gent give Recognizance in ten pounds Sterling for his appearance before his Lordship's Justice of the
Peace, nisi proin, oyer and terminer and Goal deliver to be held at Dwidning Creek in Somerset
County the first Tuesday of Aprile next to give Evidence on behalf of his Lordship's against
Richard Dinkell of and concerning a certain Robbery by him committed &c.

Whereupon the said James Shirley present herein Court in his proper person acknowledged
himself to owe and stand justly indebted unto his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sume
of ten pounds Sterling good and Lawfull money of England, of his Goods and Chattels Land &
Tenements to the use of his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors if
it happen that the said James Shirley, do not make his personall appearance before the
Justice of the Peace nisi proin, oyer and terminer and Goal delivery to be held at Dwidning Creek
in Somerset County the first Tuesday of Aprile next, and do not then and there give such
Evidence as he shalws against the said Richard Dinkell, of and concerning the Robbery aforesaid
do not thence depart without Leave of the said Justice &c.
