held here at Dwidng Beck in the County and the twentyeth day of March One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two, is  
Sent before the Justices of the Next assise this present year and termire and date delivery to be held at Dwidng  
Beck in the County and the first tuesday of Aprile next together with the court thereof for their determination  
and whereupon the said Anthony West present here in Court in his proper person is ordered to

give Recouerance with One County for his good behaviour and appearance at the Next assise to be held as  
aforesaid her. I<sup>r</sup> upon the same Anthony West, with Rendale Pewle late of Somerset County plan:

his County present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledge him selfe to owe unto his Lordship  
the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of the Province of Maryland £. viii. the sum of fiftie pounds.  
Sterling each good and Lawfull money of England of their severall goods and Chattells Land, and tenements  
to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors to be made and levied. If it happen that the  
aforesaid Anthony West do not make his personale appearance before his Lordships Justices of the Next  
assise this present year and termire and date delivery to be held at Dwidng Beck in Somerset County  
and the first tuesday of Aprile next to answer unto his said Lordships office and concerning his personage as  
and do not stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereon, and do not depart the same Court without  
Leave therof, and do not in the mean time be of the good behaviour towards his said Lordship  
and all others his good people, then the above Recouerance to be in full force & virtue otherwise.

His Lordship's command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Sarah Staples,  
Sarah Staples wife to answer unto his Lordship office and concerning her committing fornication and having had

Born of her body a bastard child her and afterward the said Sarah Staples present here  
in Court in her proper person is ordered to give Recouerance with One County for appearance at  
June Court next to answer the premises and her. Whereupon the said Sarah Staples with John Carr of  
Somerset County plante her County both present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged them  
selfe to owe unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary the sum of ten pounds Sterling each of their  
goods and Chattells Lands and tenements severally to be made and levied to the use of his said Lord-  
ship his heirs and Successors. If it happen that the aforesaid Sarah Staples do not make her personale  
appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dwidng Beck the  
first tuesday of June next, and do not answer unto his said Lordships office and concerning her committing of  
fornication, and having born of her body a bastard child; and do not stand and abide the judgment of  
the Court thereon, and do not depart the same Court without Leave therof, then the above Recouerance  
to be in full force and virtue her. —
