It is considered by the Court here that of Elizabeth Amisworth pay unto his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary for her fine here upon her imposed by reason of the premises aforesaid whosoever in form aforesaid she is convicted to thirty shillings current and that the said Elizabeth Amisworth be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid and whosoever the said Elizabeth Amisworth is ordered to give security for the payment of the several Officers fees due by reason of the premises and whosoever a certain John Dope of Somerset County planter present herein Court under take for the said Elizabeth Amisworth to pay the several Officers fees due by means of the premises aforesaid.
