Att which said next Court to witt the Twentieth day of March and Dow One thousand Seven hundred and thirty two came againe as well the said John Tunstall as the said Patrick Connolly by their attorney aforsaid and thereupon his Lordship the Right honorable the Lord Proprietary his certain Writ of Habeas Corpus unto the Justices of his County Court of Somerset also now holden Bench which said Writ followeth in these words vizt. Maryland Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Province of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the Justices and Sheriff of Somerset County greeting Whereas accertain Patrick Connolly of the same County is detained in the prison of our said County under the Custody of our said Sheriff at the Suit of certain John Tunstall assignee of Hugh Porter in plea of Debt which said plea as it is said shal depend before you our said Justices undetermined and we being willing for diverse causes that the plea aforsaid should be heard and determined before the Justices of our prov. Court Therefore we Command you that you have the body of the said Patrick Connolly by whatsoever name he be called in the plea afo together with the day and Cause of his Caption and detainer and all things therunto Relating before the Justices of our Provinciall Court to be hold at annapolis the kind the day of may next that our Justices of our said Provinciall Court may further proceed therein as to Justice appertaineth &c. hereof fail not at your perils and have you then and there this wittness Levi Gale Esq. Chief Justice of our prov. Court the twenty fourth day of Octo. in the eighteenth Year of our Dominion &c. anno q. Dow. one thousand Seven hundred thirty two &c.

which being Read and heard it is ordered by the Court here that a full transcript of the proceedings in the plea afo be made and Sent according to the tenour and Command of the writ afo &c.
