which being Read and heard it is Ordered by the Court here that a full transcript of the proceedings in the plea aforesaid be made and sent according to the tenour and Command of the writ &c.

pen that the said Mathew Hopkins do not Comply with the Law in relation to the Guardians-  
ships aforesaid, and do not deliver up unto the said Mathias Nichols his heirs or assigns  
all his Estate both Real and personall that he shall have in his hands and possession peaceably  
and quietly when he shall arrive at full age by Law to enjoy the Same &c. —
