the person who hath the Estate of the Said Martha Givans both Real and personale in possession, deliver the  
same up unto the Esq John Hardy Gardian as aforesaid ~~that~~ that the Said John Hardy receive the same Esq.  
It is Likewise further Ordered by the Court here that the Said John Hardy give Recouerance  
with two Penitents in the sum of fifty pounds Sterling for to comply with the Gardianship aforesaid Esq.  
Thereupon the Said John Hardy with James Dashiel and George Dashiel his Penitents all of Som-  
erset County Gent. present here in Court acknowledged themselves to be Indebted unto the aforesaid Martha  
Givans in the sum of fifty pounds Sterling of their Body goods or Chattells Land, tenements Joyntly and  
Separately to be made and Levied to the use of the Said Martha Givans her heirs or assignes If it shall  
be found that the aforesaid John Hardy do not comply with the Law and Ordinances in relation to the Gardianship  
aforesaid, and do not deliver up unto the said Martha Givans her heirs or assignes all her Estate, both  
real and personale, that he had ~~ever~~ taken into his hands and possession peaceably and quietly when  
she shall arrive at full age to receive the same, and required her.

Graves Bowhaw. } that he may be admitted to chose George Dashiel of Somerset County Gentleman as  
his Gardian which is granted him Esq. Whereupon the Said Graves Bowhaw present here in Court as afo-  
reid made Roane of the Said George Dashiel for his Gardian Esq.

Whereupon it is Ordered by the Court here that the Said George Dashiel take unto his care and  
possession all the Estate of the Said Graves Bowhaw both real and personale, and that the Said George  
Dashiel give Recouerance in fifty pounds Sterling with two Penitents for to comply with the Gardianship  
aforesaid Esq. Thereupon the Said George Dashiel, with John Hardy and James Dashiel his  
Penitents all of Somerset County Gent. present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged them  
selves to be Indebted unto the aforesaid Graves Bowhaw in the sum of fifty pounds Sterling of  
their Body goods or Chattells Land, or tenements Joyntly and Separately to be made and Levied to the  
use of the Said Graves Bowhaw his heirs or assignes If it shall be found that the aforesaid George  
Dashiel do not comply with the Law and Ordinances in relation to the Gardianship aforesaid, and do not  
deliver up unto the said Graves Bowhaw his heirs or assignes all his Estate both real and personale, that  
he had taken into his hands and possession, peaceably and quietly when he shall arrive at full age to  
receive the same and required her.
