Whereupon it is Ordered by the Court here that the Said Robert Watson Give Recouurance
for to Comply with the Covenants aforesaid &c.

Thereupon the Said Robert Watson present here in Court acknowledged himself Indebted
unto the Said Charles Pace the Younger in the sum of ten pounds Sterling good and Lawfull
money of his body goods or Chattels Land or tenements to the use of the said Charles Pace his heirs
or assigns to be made and Levied if it happen that the Said Robert Watson do not Learn
his said apprenticeship during the term aforesaid to Read well in the Bible and Likewise find and
provide for the Said Charles Pace the Younger Sufficient meat drink washing Dressing and
Clothing make for him to have and wear during the term aforesaid &c.

to Blanuer King

Blanuer King son of Rypsher King late of Somervel County deceased.

Came hys into Court and prayd that he may be admitted for to Rose a Servt to David
Wilson of Somervel County Gentleman Gardain, which is by the Court hys unto him granted &c.
Thereupon the said Blanuer King makes Choice of the said David Wilson as his Gardain accordingly
Whereupon it is Ordered by the Court here that the said David Wilson take into his Care and
possession all the Estate of the said Blanuer King both lease and personall, and that he give good
Security for to Comply with the Gardain ship aforesaid &c.

Thereupon the Said David Wilson with Robert King and Henry Ballard Esq: Security
all of Somervel County Gentleman present here in Court acknowledged themselves to be Indebted unto the
said Blanuer King in the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling good and Lawfull money
of England of their body goods or Chattels Land or tenements joyntly severally toke
made and Levied to the use of the said Blanuer King his heirs or assigns.

If it happen that the aforesaid David Wilson do not Comply with the Law
in Relation to the Gardain ship aforesaid, and do not deliver up peaceably and quicly
unto the said Blanuer King his heirs or assigns all his Estate both lease and personall
when he shall arrive at full age to receive the same or when the said David Wilson shalde
be Legally required &c.
