of Algernon Isaac Bredall of the County aforesaid in relation to the bound of Land called Oliver's
portion containing one hundred and fifty acres we therefore require you or any three or two of you
at sometime and place as to you or any three or two of you shall seem convenient you mete on the
Land called Oliver's portion (you first having taken your Oath on the Holy Evangelist of Almighty
God according to art of assembly in such case made and provided) and there cause to come before you
any three or two of you all such Evidence as shall be to you or any three or two of you nominate
by the said Complainant or Def: if any and that you or any three or two of you examine
them upon their corporall oaths to be by you or any three or two of you administered on the
Holy Evangelist of Almighty God in the presence of the Complainant or Def: if any
touching the truth or Remembrances of their knowledge or any thing that may relate
to the cause aforesd and that Producing the severall Deposition in Writing you
send the same together with this our Commission Under your or any three or two
of your hands and Seals to us to our County Court of Somerset with all convenient
Speed witness Robert King Gent Chief Justice of our said Court the twenty fourth
Day of June in the Eighteenth Year of our Dominion Anno Domini One thousand
Seven hundred and thirty two. On the back side of the foregoing Commission it was

aged forty years or there abouts being Sworn upon the holy Evangelist of Almighty
God deposeth and saith that ther was a marked Beach formerly standing
Within about ten foot of the place where he stood where he caused a Saw of his Stake
To be put down being about forty three yards West from the Second Row of Apple-
trees in the North End of ~~his~~ Isaac Bredall's Orchard and that he has
often heard the said Beach was the second Bounder of the aforesd Land called Oliver's
portion and further saith Not -

John Holloway late of the County aforesd aged fifty four years or there abouts being
