Portion containing One hundred and fifty acres we therefore Require you or any three or two of you  
at some time and place as to you or any three or two of you shall seem convenient you make on the  
said Land called Oliver's portion (you first having taken your Oaths on the Holy Evangelist of Almighty  
God according to act of assembly in such case made and provided) and there cause to come before you or  
any three or two of you all such Evidence as shall be to you or any three or two of you Promis-  
ed by the said Complainant or Def. if any and that you or any three or two of you Examine  
them upon their Corporall oaths to be by you or any three or two of you Administered on the  
Holy Evangelist of Almighty God in the presence of the Complainant or Def. if any -  
touching the truth or Remembrances of their knowledge or any thing that may relate  
to the Cause aforesaid and that Reducing the Several Deposition in Writing you -  
send the Same together with this our Commission Under your or any three or two  
of your hands and Seals to us to our County Court of Somerset with all convenient  
Speed Witness Robert King Gent Chief Justice of our said Court the twenty fourth  
Day of June the Eighteenth Year of our Dominion Ann. Dom. One thousand  
Seven hundred and thirty two. On the back side of the foregoing Commission it was  
thus Endorsed Viz: -

Somerset County Vt. By Vertue of a Commission to us Directed from the Worshipfull  
the Justices of the County aforesaid to Examine Witness in Relation to the bounds of a tract  
of Land called Oliver's Portion belonging to Mr. Isaiah Bredall of the County aforesaid  
have taken as follows Viz: Joseph Gray of Somerset County aforesaid Planter  
Aged forty Years or thereabouts being Sworn upon the Holy Evangelist of Almighty  
God Depoeth and Saith that there was a marked Beach formerly Standing  
Within about Ten foot of the Place we then Stood where we caused a Sasopis Stakes  
To be put Down being about forty three Yards West from the Second Row of Apls -  
trees in the North End of ~~the~~ Isaiah Bredall's Orchard and that he has  
often heard the said Beach was the Second Bounder of the aforesaid Land called Oliver's  
Portion and further saith Not -
