The petition aforesaid being read and heard and fully understood and mature deliberation there  
upon had Wherefore it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid William Freeman be for the future Levy  
free as by his petition aforesaid he is paid £6.

Giddion Jones. } Giddion Jones an orphan is bound by the Court to be an apprentice unto Francis  
bound to      Henderson, until he arrives at the age of twenty one years the said Giddion Jones being  
Francis Henderson      two years old last Christmas, the said Giddion Jones to serve his said master Francis Henderson  
for the full term aforesaid, during which term the said Giddion Jones his said master will faithfully shall  
serve his masters keeps, his commandments Lawfully and honestly every where willingly shall do, and make  
things as good and faithful servant shall demean himself towards his said master and all his during the  
term aforesaid. — In consideration of which service the said Francis Henderson present here in  
court in his proper person covenanteth with the Justices of the same Court, in Court specially sitting, on

an apprentice to have and wear during the term aforesaid &c. —

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court here that the aforesaid Francis Henderson give Recouerance  
with one Scurity for to comply with the covenants aforesaid &c. —

Whereupon the said Francis Henderson, with Benjamin Henderson of Somerset County planter his  
Scurity both present herein and in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to be indebted unto  
unto the said Giddion Jones in the sum of twenty five Sterling Pounds good and Lawfull money of England  
of their severall goods, and Chattels Lands and tenements to be made and Levied ~~and Seized~~ ~~and Seized~~  
~~and Seized~~ ~~and Seized~~ of the said Giddion Jones his heirs and assigns if it happen that the aforesaid Francis Henderson  
do not during the term of servitude aforesaid teach his said apprentice the trade of a weaver and to teach

above his common wearing Cloathes, and do not Likewise provide for his said apprentice meat drink  
washing Lodging and Cloathing and all other Necesarys sufficient for such an apprentice to have and
