

David Brown Esq. of the County of his guardian, which is granted him. Thereupon these said John Smith present here in Court as aforesaid did make make Oath of the said David Brown as his guardian.

It is ordered by the Court here that the said David Brown give Recognizance with one Security for to comply with the Guardianship aforesaid. and Likewise that the said David Brown take under his Care and Custody all the estate of the said John Smith both Real and personal &c —

Thereupon the said David Brown with Henry Ballant of Somerset County Gentleman his Security both present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to owe and stand justly indebted unto the said John Smith in the Sum of twenty pounds Sterling good and Lawfull money of England of their bodies goods or Chattels Lands or Tenements jointly and severally to the use of the said John Smith his heirs and assigns to be made and Levied. If it happen that the said David Brown do not comply with the Law in relation to the Guardianship aforesaid or do not deliver up unto the said John Smith his heirs or assigns all his Estate both Real & personal that he shall have in his hands or possession peaceably and quietly whenever the same shall be Legally Required &c.

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court here that the Just. of Somerset County return a panel of grand Jurors immediately to enquire for the body of the County aforesaid on behalf of his Lordship.

Thereupon Proclamation being made in Common form and the Just. of Somerset County to witt Joshua Cole well Gent. being called made return of the names of grand Jurors as followeth vizt James Brown, Robert Gwain, Edmund Hough, Thomas Carey, John Shobley, John Pope, George Maglar, Benjamin Venable, Daniel Cadery, John Wilkain, William Catlin, William Turpin Junr. Henry Grey manor John on Hill John Reddish Robert Hale, David Brown Philip Adams, James Dashiell Junr. Jacob Cadery and George Beuston, and whereupon proclamation being made againe in Common form and the Jurors aforesaid so as aforesaid Impanelled being severally called over by their names did appear as above, and thereupon they were sworn and charged and sent out to consider, soon after the Jurors aforesaid so as aforesaid Impanelled sworn and charged as aforesaid Return here into Court and being severally called over did appear and deliver to the same Court here the following Inditment and presentments to witt Inditment against Edmund Dikerson and presentment against Henry Cneal, and Mary Glaster thereupon the grand Jurors aforesaid are discharged and ordered that they be allowed five hundred pounds of to beano for their publick Service this Court to be paid next Levy Court and against the said Edmund Dikerson, Henry Cneal and Mary Glaster so as aforesaid presented and Indited It is ordered that Execiōs Issue against them Returnable to next Court &c
