petn. } petition of Solomon Colebourn most humbly sheweth. -

That whereas your petitioner is possessed of part of a tract of Land called Pomefret lying in Somerset County the bounds whereof are decayed, therefore your petitioner prays your worships to appoint Commissioners to examine Evidence in relation to the said bounds according to an act of assembly in that case made and provided and your petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray . .

The petition afo being read and heard and fully understood and mature deliberation thereupon had. wherefore it is considered by the Justices here that the afo Solomon Colebourn have a Commission as by the petition afo is said and that William Planson, Thomas Williams, David Wilson and John Waters of Somerset County Gent. be Commissioners and execute the same Commission according to act of assembly in such case made and provided for.

Thomas Hayward of Somerset County produced here in Court a Commission (from the Honble Edward Jennings Esq^r Secretary of the Province of Maryland) as Clerk of the County of Somerset, who is approved of, he taking the Severall Oaths to the Government with the oath of God and Subscribed the Oath of abjuration and Test. Thereupon the said Thomas Hayward took the severall Oaths appointed by act of assembly to the Government to be taken, with the oath of God, and Subscribed the Oath of abjuration and Test. & is admitted to his business for.

Upon the petition of Samuel Hopkins sent to this Court It is ordered by the same Court that the said Samuel Hopkins be discharged for the future from paying of Taxes for himself for.

John Beachamp } John Beachamp son of Thomas Beachamp Late of Somerset County ded. an orphan
Chose Guardian } above the age of fourteen years came hither into Court in his proper person and prays that he
} may be admitted to Chose afo Edward Hull of Somerset County Carpenter as his
Guardian which is unto him granted for. Thereupon the said John Beachamp present hither Court
did make Chose of the said Edward Hull as his Guardian, whereupon it is ordered by the Court here
that ~~the~~ John White of Botomoka deliver up unto the said Edward Hull Guardian as afo all the
estate of the said John Beachamp both real & personal, and that the said Edward Hull receive the same.

It is Likewise ordered by the Court here that the afo Edward Hull give Recognizance with two Security for to comply with the Guardian ship afo for.

Thereupon the said Edward Hull with Jonathan Cottingham and Tho^r Moor both of Somerset County planters his security are present here in Court in their proper persons
