Sarah Givans. Sarah Givans of Somerset County Spinster present her in Court is appointed as  
Guardian to Guardian unto Jane Givans an orphan under the age of fourteen years &c.  
Jane Givans. And it is ordered by the same Court that the said Sarah Givans take into her Care & pos-  
session the said Orphan, and all her Estate, both real and personal, and further it is Ordered that  
the said Sarah Givans give Recognizance with One Penny for to comply with the Guardianship &c.  
Thereupon the said Sarah Givans with John M'Gester of Somerset County Gent her attorney both  
present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves to owe and be indebted unto  
the said Jane Givans in the sum of forty pounds Sterling lawfully and severally of their body, goods  
or Chattels Land or tenements to be made and Levied to the use of the said Jane Givans her heirs  
or assigns. If it happen that the said Sarah Givans do not comply with the Laws in relation  
to the Guardianship aforesaid, and do not deliver up unto the said Jane Givans her heirs or assigns all her  
estate both real and personal, that she shall have in her hands, and possess peaceably and quietly  
when ever the same shall be legally required her.

Lewis Gale Esq<sup>r</sup>. Gale Esq<sup>r</sup> until he arrives at the age of Twenty one years, the said Drake Drum-  
mond the younger being fifteen year of age the Eleventh day of August next, the said  
Drake Drummond the younger to serve his said master the full term of him as during which  
time the said apprentice his said master well and faithfully shall serve his master keep his command-  
ments lawfully and honestly every where willingly shall do and in all things as good and faithful  
Servant shall demean himself towards his said master and all his during the term aforesaid —

In consideration of which Lewis the said Lewis Gale Esq<sup>r</sup> present here in Court in his pro-  
per person Covenanteth with the Justices of the same Court in Court judicially sitting on behalf of the  
said Drake Drummond the young that to the said Lewis Gale during the term aforesaid will endeavor to see  
that his said apprentice during the term aforesaid shall be taught or instructed in the art of Navigation so  
far as may be sufficient to navigate a vessel across the sea from one Seaport to another  
and likewise provide for his said apprentice meat drink washing Drying and Cleaning and all other  
necessaries sufficient for such an apprentice to have and wear during the term aforesaid —

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court here that the said Lewis Gale Esq<sup>r</sup> give Recognizance with  
One Penny for to comply with the Covenants aforesaid. Thereupon the said Lewis Gale Esq<sup>r</sup> with  
Thomas Hayward his attorney both present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves
