Thereupon a certain John Magloghlin of Somerset County planter present before the Court undertakes for the said Joshua Edge that if in law the said Francis Allen should recover Judgment in the plea aforesaid against the said Joshua Edge or that the said Joshua Edge shall be therein convicted, that then he the said Joshua Edge shall pay the condemnation of the Court thereupon or tender his body to the custody of the Sher. of Somerset County in satisfaction thereof or that he said John Magloghlin will do it for him.
