June and Day One thousand Seven hundred & Ninety three and had a hearing of his present suit, and being justly demanded how she would acquit herself of the premises set up on her Imposed, says that of the premises set above upon her Imposed she is guilty thereof and puts herself upon the favour of the Court, and makes oath that Moses Chaille Jnd. is the begetter of the Child she stands presented for but hath not wherewithal to pay her fine for the fact set her -

Wherefore it is Considered by the Justices here that the afo Ann More be whipt with ten Lashes well laid on while the blood appear and that she be taken to Horsongay as to the corporal punishment afo command is given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he do thenceof immideate Execution by whipping of the afo Ann More at the publick whipping post with ten Lashes on the Bear Bank well laid on while the blood appears and afterwards in the same Court came the same Sheriff with Joshua Radewell Gent and made return that he had done the Execution of his Judgment afo unto the corporal punishment afo he was commanded. Whereupon the said Ann More master to wit Christopher Glad present here in Court pray that the said Ann More may be adjudged to serve him after the Execution of her Indented time ~~one year~~ for the trouble, and charge, and Loss of time, where the said Ann More Lay in, and for maintaining of her Child, and for tobacco paid on and of the foreign prosecution which amounts in the whole, for trouble, costs, charges, and Loss of time, and maintaining of the Child of her paid on and of the afo prosecution ~~and in the like~~ to Seven hundred and fifty five pounds of tobacco no ~~more~~ Wherupon the said Ann More is adjudged to serve her said Master Christopher Glad after the Execution of her Indented Service ~~one year~~ of Eleven full months to commence at the Execution afo, which eleven month Service afo is adjudged full Satisfaction for the afo Seven hundred and fifty five pounds of tobacco damages and paid as afo ~~she~~ and that the afo ~~she~~ Glad to other Glad they unto the said Ann More all her freedom due, allowed by act of Assembly 1705 Wherupon it is ordered by the Court here that the aforesaid Ann More give security for her appearance at August Court next to give evidence against Moses Chaille Jnd. on behalf of his Lordship her. Thereupon Christopher Glad of Somerset County planter present here in Court in his proper person undertakes for the said Ann More and acknowledged himself to be indebted unto his Lordship the Right honble the Lord Proprietary in five pounds Sterling good and Lawfull money of England or his body goods or chattells Lands or tenement to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors to be made and levied -

If it happen that the said Ann More do not make her personal appearance before the Justices of his said Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Bridgwater the third Monday of August then next, and do not give evidence on behalf of his said Lordship against Moses Chaille Jnd. and do not Depart the same Court without leave thereoff
