Likewise the said Richard Driskill is ordered by the Court here to give Security as well for the Several Officers their fees due on a Jury sworn against him for Robbery in March Court Last past as for the Several Officers fees due by means of the premises aforesaid, Thomason a certain Moses Duskey present here in Court undertakes for the said Richard Driskill to pay the Several Officers fees due on the Jury Sworn in March Court Last aforesaid, as the Several Officers fees due by reason of the premises on the Information aforesaid &c.

Littleton Bowen appears according to his Recognizance entered into for his good behaviour and appearance to answer his being suspected of carrying away &c. and nothing being objected against him the said Littleton Bowen is discharged &c.

that on the twentyeth day of June anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three Came into Court before the the worshipfull William Pasit Esq. and his associates Justices of the Peace Robert Jenckins Henry Gault. who proventer for the Lord Proprietary and gives the Court to understand and be informed that Thomas Vance late of the said County planter the twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and thirty one in the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court did Commit fornication with a certain Sarah Hyde of the County aforesaid Spinster and on the body of the said Sarah then and there did begett a bastard Child to the high displeasure of almighty God and to the Evil Example of all others in such case offending and against the form of the Statute of assembly in such cases made and provided wherefore the said Robert Jenckins Henry praye of advise of the Court in the premises and due process of Law thereon against the said Thomas may Issue

Thereupon command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said Thomas Vance if he ~~was~~ and afterward in the same Court to wit the twentieth day of June anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty three before the Justices of the same Court Came the said Thomas Vance by Francis Allen his attorney and had averring of the Information aforesaid, and says that he cannot gain say but that the said Thomas Vance is guilty of the premises in the Information aforesaid in manner and form above against him.
