honorable the Lord Proprietary One hundred pounds of tobacco for his fine for the trespass and assault
in the Indictment contained whereof he is Convict and that the said Richard Driskill be -
taken to Satisfie his said Lordship of the fine and the Sherif of Somerset County to wit Joshua Goldwell
Sheriff present here in Court tooke charge off & said Richard Driskill and right so.

Likewise the said Richard Driskill is ordered by the Court here to give Security as well for the
Several Officers their fees due on a Jury sworn against him for Robbery in March Court last past
as for the Several Officers fee due by means of the premises &c. Thereupon a certaine Mose Durley
present here in court undertaken for the said Richard Driskill to pay the Several Officers fees due on the
Jury Sworn in March Court last &c, as the Several Officers fees due by reason of the premises
on the Indictment aforesaid.

Littleton Bowen appears according to his Recouurance entered into for his good behaviour
and appearance to answer him being suspected of being a quinary &c and nothing being objected against
him the said Littleton Bowen is discharged &c.

anno Domini: One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety three Comer into Court before the
the worshipfull William Savil Esq: and his associates Justices of the Peace Robert Denchins
Henry Gant who prosector for the Lord Proprietary and gives the Court to understand and be informed
that Thomas Vance late of the said County planter the twentieth day of March in the year of Our Lord
One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety one in the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court did
committ fornication with a certaine Sarah Gode of the County aforesaid spinner and on the body of the
said Sarah then and there did begett a bastard Child to the high displeasure of Almighty God and
to the Gode Example of all other in such base Offending and against the form of the act of
assembly in such cases made and provided wherfore the said Robert Denchins Henry prayes of
advise of the Court in the premises and due process of Law thereon against the said Thomas
Vance.

Whereupon command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said
Thomas Vance if he doth not appear and afterward in the same Court to wit the twentieth day of June anno Domini
One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety three before the Justices of the same Court came the said Thomas Vance by
Francis Allen his attorney and had alswereing of the information aforesaid and says that he cannot gainsay but that
the said Thomas Vance is guilty of the premises in the Indictment aforesaid in manner and form above against
him.
