

and the said Edward Chambers Esq^d for the cause aforesaid should not remain forfeited but he should ^{only} forthwith be haled, and none so to do appear, It is agreed that John Caldwell Esq^d of Somerset County be commanded by writ of the Lord Proprietary that now is under the Seal of this Court the said Vessel or Shallop together with her Tackle apparel and furniture, three hogsheads of Tobacco three deer Skins & one Skillet by the Bulk of good and Lawfull men of the said County Justly and faithfully to cause to be appraised making an Indenture hereof between him and the said appraisers &c so that one part of the said Indenture he have here immediately during the sitting of this Court at Doding Creek and now here afterward during the sitting of the Court the said Just. Return here the writ and together with another Indenture to the same writ annexed of which Indenture the tenor is as followeth art. This Indenture made the twenty first day of June one thousand seven hundred and thirty three &c. witnesseth that we James Jones and John Murray appraisers according to writ to the Just. of Somerset County directed and hereunto annexed have viewed and appraised the Vessel or Shallop called the Somerset together with her Tackle apparel and furniture, three hogsheads of tobacco, three deer Skins and one Skillet at the sum of Twenty four pounds Nineteen shillings and Six pence Curr. money I do witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and Seals the day and year above written upon which was further proclamation made for the said Lord the King for the manner in that if any person would inform the Court here wherefore the said Vessel or Shallop with her Tackle apparel and furniture three hogsheads of Tobacco, three deer Skins, and one Skillet, should not be condemned for the cause aforesaid, or if any would give more for the said Vessel or Shallop Tackle apparel and furniture, three hogsheads of tobacco, three deer Skins and one Skillet than the appraisement he should come forth and be haled, but none so doing.

Therefore it is considered by this Court that the said Vessel or Shallop with her Tackle apparel and furniture, three hogsheads of tobacco, three deer skins and one Skillet remain forfeited for the cause aforesaid, and that the Lord the King that now is have one third part thereof, that the said Lord Proprietary have one third part thereof and that the said Edward Chambers Esq^d have the other third part thereof.
