

and the said Edward Chambers Esq for the cause afo should not remain forfeited that he should <sup>come</sup> forth & be heard, and none so to do appear, It is agreed that Joshua Caldwell Shd. of Somerset County be Comanded by writ of the Lord propriety that now is under the seal of this Court the said Vessel or Skallop together with her Tackle apparell and furniture, three hoggs of Tobaco three deer Skins & one Skillett by the oath of good and Lawfull men of the said County Justly and faithfully to Cause to be appraised, making an Indenture hereof between him and the said appraisers &c so that one part of the said Indenture he have here Immediately during the sitting of this Court at dividing Creek and now hereafterward, during the sitting of the Court the said Shd. Return here the writ afo together with a certain Indenture to the same writ annexed of which Indenture the tenor is as followeth  
 wit. This Indenture made the twenty first day of June one thousand seven hundred and thirty three  
 witnesseth that we James Jones and John Murray appraisers according to a writ to the Shd. of Somerset County directed and hereunto annexed have viewed and appraised the Vessel or Skallop called the Somerset together with her Tackle apparell and furniture, three hoggs heads of Tobaco, three deer Skins and one Skillett at the sum of Twenty four pounds fifteen shillings and Six pence Current money In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and Seals the day and year above written Upon which was further proclamation made for the said Lord the King (in the manner is) that if any person would Inform the Court here wherefore the said Vessel or Skallop with her Tackle apparell and furniture three hoggs heads of Tobaco, three deer Skins, and one Skillett, should not be condemned for the cause afo, or if any would give more for the said Vessel or Skallop Tackle apparell and furniture, three hoggs heads of Tobaco, three deer Skins and one Skillett than the appraisment he should come forth and be heard, but none so doing.

Therefore it is considered by the Court how that the said Vessel or Skallop with her Tackle apparell and furniture, three hoggs heads of Tobaco, three deer skins and one Skillett remain forfeited for the cause afo, and that the Lord the King that now is have one third part thereof, that the said Lord propriety have one third part thereof and that the said Edward Chambers Esq have the other third part thereof
