

John nor can she say but that the said Hugh Porter in his Life time did assume upon himself in manner and form as the app John above against her hath complained, and as to the damage of the same John by him by occasion of the premises in that part Sustained the same many worth and Confesseth that the app John has Sustained Damages by occasion of the premises further than his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in that part apposed to Twenty Seven pound five shillings and three pence three farthings Current money of Maryland and no more, to be Levied of the goods and Chattells which were of the app Hugh Porter at the time of his death and when to the hands of her the app Mary shall happen to come to be administered together with his Costs and Charges app to him to be adjudged by which the said p^{ts} doth not gain say &c.

Therefore by Consent of the parties aforesaid it is Considered that the app John Naval Receiver against the app Mary Porter &c of the app Hugh Porter his Damages app to the app Twenty Seven pound five shillings and three pence three farthings Current money of Maryland by the same Mary in form app Confessed as also from hundred & fourteen pound of tobacco for his Costs and charges by him about his suit in that part apposed by the Court here adjudged to be Levied of the goods and Chattells which were of the app Hugh at the time of his death and when to the hands of the app Mary hereafter shall happen to come to be administered to the app Mary in Mary &c.
