Therefore by Consent of the parties and it is considered that the said Thomas shall recover against the said Isacker Wilcox his Damages and to the said fifty nine pounds ten shillings Current money of Maryland by the same Isacker in form and Confessed as also three hundred & nine pounds of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges and to the same Thomas at his request by the Court here and Consent of the parties and adjudged and the said Isacker in Merry &c.
