At which day the plea afo. with all things thereunto Relating was by Act of Assembly and the Court  
Adjourned until next Court to be hold at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June Next.

At which said next Court to witt the Twentieth day of June and Dow. one thousand seven hundred and thirty three came  
against the said Lewin Gale, George Gale John Gale and Mathias Gale by their attorney afo. and the said Mary Borta  
Esquire as afo. by Francis Allen her attorney afo. Comes and defends the force and Injury whereof and saith that she  
cannot give way the action afo. of the afo. Lewin, George, John and Mathias Gales nor can she say but that the  
writing Obligatory afo. is the deed of the same Hugh, nor but that she detains from the afo. Lewin, George John and  
Mathias Gales the afo. Sixty pounds Currant money in manner and form as the afo. Lewin George, John and Mathi-  
as Gales above against her hath declared &c

Therefore it is considered that the afo. Lewin Gale George Gale and John Gale and Mathias  
Gale Recover against the afo. Mary Borta Esquire as afo. their debt afo. and their damage by reason of  
the detaining of the same debt to three hundred & seventy eight pounds of tobacco of  
their part by the Court here adjudged of the goods and Chattels which were of the afo. Hugh Borta at the time of
