Province of Maryland Blacksmith was demand to answer unto Samuel Reek of New Castle County upon  
Delaware Planter of a plea that he Render unto him Seventy pounds lawfull Silver money of  
the Province of Maryland which to him he owes and Unjustly Detains &c.

And Whereupon the said Samuel by Francis Allen his Attorney saith that Whereas the said  
Edw<sup>d</sup> the sixth day of March Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and thirty one by his  
Certain writing obligatory acknowledged himself to be bound unto the said Samuel in the aforesaid  
Seventy pounds lawfull Silver money of the province of Maryland to be paid unto the said Samuel  
when he should be therunto Required hath the said Edward the Oft<sup>r</sup> Required the said Seventy  
pounds to the said Samuel hath not Rendered but there being to him hitherto to Render hath  
done and still doth Deny and Unjustly detain To if Damage of the said Samuel offerty  
pounds money aforesaid And thereupon he brings Suit &c. and he brings into for: here of  
writing obligatory aforesaid with the seal of the said Edward signed w<sup>t</sup> the debt aforesaid  
in form aforesaid doth witness whose date is the Day and Year abovesaid.

Cornell and Maketh Return thereof to the Sher<sup>r</sup> here endorsed in these words following viz  
Ep<sup>r</sup> Corpus Declaration delivered in time of Joshua Colwick Sher<sup>r</sup>  
At which day the pleas aforesaid with all things thereunto Relating was by Act of Assembly  
and the Court adjourned until next Court to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of  
June next.

At which said next Court to wit Twentieth day of June and Dow<sup>r</sup> One thousand seven  
hundred and thirty three came againe the said Samuel Reek by his attorney aff<sup>r</sup> and the said Edward Clift  
by Robert Dennis Henry by his attorney Likewise Cornell and Maketh that he can not pay the action  
aff<sup>r</sup> of the said Samuel Reek nor can he say but that the writing Obligatory aff<sup>r</sup> is the deed of the same  
Edward, nor but that he owe the same Samuel the aforesaid Seventy pounds Lawfull money of Maryland  
in manner and form as the aforesaid Samuel Reek above against him hath declared for.

Therefore it is Considered that the aforesaid Samuel Reek Recover against the said Edward Clift  
399: his debt aff<sup>r</sup> and his damages by occasion of the detaining of that sum debt to Three hundred and  
Nineteen pounds aforesaid by the Court here of his agent adjudged and the aforesaid  
in every fee
