

At which said Next Court to witt Twentieth Day of June Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty three came againe the said Isaac Atkinson by his Attorney afo. and thereupon the said Patrick Connelly being called appears and thereupon the said Patrick Connelly at the prayer of the afo Isaac Atkinson by his attorney afo is adjudged to give Speial Bail to the afo Isaac Atkinson but for want thereof the said Patrick Connelly is committed into the Custody of the Sher. of Somerset County: there to remaine & the said Sher. to witt Joshua Caldwell Gent: present herein Court took Charge of the said Patrick Connelly accordingly &c.

And afterwards the said Patrick Connelly in Custody as afo. present herein Court defendes the fine and injury when he said Patrick that he cannot say the afo. of the afo Isaac nor can he say but that he did assume upon himself in Manner and form as the afo Isaac above against him hath complained and as to the damage of the said Isaac by him by Occasion of the Promises in that part sustained the same Patrick says and Confesseth that the afo Isaac has sustained Damages by Occasion of the promises further than his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part appoynd to Nine hundred pounds of Pork and not more and because the afo Isaac deny not this but the same Allegation Confesseth to be True praye Judgmt. for those Damages above Confessed and his Costs and Charges afo. to him Adjudged &c.

Therefore by Consent of the parties afo. it is considered that the afo Isaac Atkinson recover against the afo Patrick Connelly his Damages afo. to the afo Nine hundred pounds of pork by the said Patrick in form afo. Confessed as also Two hundred and eighty four pounds of Tob. for his Costs and Charges afo. to the same Isaac at his Request by the Court here and Consent of the parties afo. Adjudged And the afo Patrick in Meryitt. Whereupon the said Patrick Connelly present herein Court with proper person is at the prayer of the afo Isaac Atkinson by his attorney afo. committed into the Custody of the Sher. of Somerset County there to remaine until the said Isaac of his Damages afo. should be fully Satisfied the said Sher. to witt Joshua Caldwell Gent: present herein Court took Charge of the said Patrick Connelly accordingly &c.

Rt. Capp: John Tunstall . . . . . Command was given to the Sher of Somerset County that he should take Nathaniel Foche James Peiree and John Wood late of Somerset County Merch<sup>t</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup>. of all and Singular the Goods and Chattels Rights and Credits which were of Hugh Arbuthnot late of London Merchant Dec<sup>d</sup> if they should be found in his Balique and them should safe keep so that he might have their Bodies before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Dodingbrook the third Day of March next to answer unto John Tunstall of a plea of Trespas upon the Case &c. And that thereof he should not fail &c.

And the aforesaid John Tunstall by Rob. Jenkins Henry his Attorney Complain against the said Nath. James and John in the plea afo. as followeth viz. Somerset's Nathaniel Foche James Peiree and John Wood late of Somerset County Merch<sup>t</sup> and Adm<sup>r</sup>. of all and singular the goods and Chattels Rights and Credits which were of Hugh Arbuthnot late of London Merch<sup>t</sup> Dec<sup>d</sup>. were Attached to answer unto
