

At which said Next Court to Witt Twentioth day of June anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and thirty three came against the Said Isaac Atkinson by his Attorney aff<sup>d</sup>. and thereupon the said Patrick Connally being called appears and there upon the said Patrick Connally at the prayer of the aff<sup>d</sup> Isaac Atkinson by his attorney aff<sup>d</sup> is adjudged to give Special Bail to the action aff<sup>d</sup> but for want thereof the said Patrick Connally is committed into the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County there to remaine &c. the said aff<sup>d</sup> to wit Joshua Edwells yeare present herein Court took Charge of the said Patrick Connally accordingly he

And afterwards the said Patrick Connally in custody as aff<sup>d</sup> for said Isaac Atkinson doth the true and fulling when he and saith that he cannot say the <sup>action</sup> of the aff<sup>d</sup> Isaac nor could say but that he did aff<sup>d</sup> upon himself in manner and form as the aff<sup>d</sup> Isaac above against him hath complained and as to the damage of the said Isaac by him by Occasion of the Promises in that part sustained the same Patrick says and confesseth that the aff<sup>d</sup> Isaac has Sustained Damages by Occasion of the promises further then his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part appered to Nine hundred pounds of Pork and no more and because the aforesd Isaac doth not this but the same Allegation confesseth to be True prays Judgment for those Damages above Confessed and his Costs and Charges aff<sup>d</sup> to him Adjudged &c.

Therefore by Consent of the parties aff<sup>d</sup>  
it is Considered that the aff<sup>d</sup> Isaac Atkinson Recover against the aff<sup>d</sup> Patrick Connally  
his damages aff<sup>d</sup> to the aff<sup>d</sup> Nine hundred pounds of Pork by the same Patrick informed  
Confessed also Two hundred and Eighty four pounds of Do<sup>r</sup> for his Costs and Charges aff<sup>d</sup>  
to the same Isaac at his Request by the Court here and consent of the parties aff<sup>d</sup> Adjudged  
And the aff<sup>d</sup> Patrick in Money Do<sup>r</sup> — Whereupon the said Patrick Connally present herein  
Court in his proper person is at the prayer of the aff<sup>d</sup> Isaac Atkinson by his attorney aff<sup>d</sup> Committed  
into the custody of the Sheriff of Somerset County there to remaine until the said Isaac of his damages aff<sup>d</sup> should  
be fully satisfied the said Sheriff to wit Joshua Edwells yeare present herein Court took Charge of the said
