in your custody safe keep so that you have them before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Green

the third Tuesday of November next then and there to be condemned according to act of assembly to and for the use of a certain Robert

Warren Junr. unless the said Humphry Hughes by himselfe or his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Robert Warren

in asse of the said papers upon the case according to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your bailiwick you make

known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make of same attachment that he she or they be appear before

the Justices of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to show cause if any he she or they have why the same goods Chattels

Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made

according to act of assembly in such case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall

execute this writ that you make known unto our said Justices at the day and place aforesaid Save you than & how this writ

Whereupon the aforesaid Robert Warren by James Shirley his attorney Cometh unto Court and pray that the said two

pound three Shillings and six pence current money so as aforesaid attached as of the Rights and Credits of the said Hum-

phry Hughes may be condemned in the hands of the said Robert Warren towards Satisfying unto the aforesaid Robt

Warren the said two pound three Shillings & six pence current money and all costs accruing upon the writ of

attachment aforesaid
