In pursuance to an act of assembly of this province now in force, and in obedience to the aforesaid warrant the following attachment was issued ^{as a rule} the Goods and Chattels rights and credits of the aforesaid John Gordon the tenour whereof followeth in these words viz.
 Somers & Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore To the Sher. of Somerset County greeting we Command you that you Attach any the Goods, Chattels rights or Credits of John Gordon late of ... County ... to the value of forty two pounds, Eighteen Shillings and Seven pence ... money and one thousand pounds of Tobacco And when you have the same so Attached on any part thereof w: Same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before the Justice of our County to be held at ... the kind holiday of ... next to them and there to be ... according to act of assembly to and for the use of ... Thomas Gordon unless the said John Gordon by himselfe or his Attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Thomas Gordon in a plea of the said act of assembly upon the case ... And that by good and lawful men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same Attachment that he she or they be and appear before the Justice of our County to be held as afo: to the said cause if any he she or they have why the same Goods, Chattels rights or Credits so Attached in his her or their hands ought not to be ... and Execution there of had and made according to the form of the act of assembly in such case made and provided if he she or they if shall seem unto you and how you shall execute this writ that you make known unto the said Justice of our County the 22 day of August next in the 16th year of our Dominion ... Anno. Dom. 1730
