A Copy of the foregoing declaration and amount were made and sent to be served on the Defend^t. in Custody
as aforesaid - All which said writ came to wit the Twentieth day of November and said One thousand Seven hund=
red and thirty Nine againe as well the aforesaid Robert Gordon by his attorney aforesaid as the said James Rowland in
his proper person in Custody as aforesaid, and through the Sher: of Somerset County to wit John Pennell Gent^l had
delivered to the aforesaid James Rowland in Custody as aforesaid the Copy of the aforesaid declaration & amount
according to Law & such Copy made and provided - Through the aforesaid Robert Gordon by his attorney
aforesaid prays that the aforesaid James Rowland in Custody as aforesaid to his declaration aforesaid may
Answer - ^{and} the aforesaid James Rowland in Custody as aforesaid hath day (until the third day of this term) to him
given by the Court how to answer &c. And the same James Rowland in Custody as aforesaid at the same day ^{being} solemnly
called Cometh not but nor says nothing in bar or preclusion of the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Robert Gordon
by which the same Robert Remaneth against the aforesaid James Rowland in Custody as aforesaid those of undefended &c.

Wherefore the aforesaid Robert his damages by Occasion of the non performance of the promise &
assumption aforesaid against the aforesaid James ought to recover &c. Wherupon all the prayer of the aforesaid
Robert and by the Consent of the same Remaneth that the Justice how according to act of assembly in such Case
made and provided, aforesaid the damages of the same Robert by Occasion of the non performance of the pro=
