 John Mory, Robert Mitchell, William Colbourne, Thomas Keane, Walter Darby John Gray Junr. George
 Benston William Mills and Abraham Smith who being duly elected byed and Sworn to say the truth
 in the premises upon their Oath do say that the aforesaid Charles Goson did assume upon himselfe
 in manner and form as the aforesaid Ann^{or} above against him hath Complaind, and asessed the
 Damages of the same Ann beyond her Costs and Charges by her about her ~~damages~~
 apposed to forty three pounds Seven Shillings and four pence ^{half penny} Sterling money, and for these Costs &
 Charges to one pound of tobacco &c. but because the Court here their Judgment of aid upon the premises
 and Verdict, not as yett are advised, day thereof is Given to the parties aforesaid until the next
 Court, of their Judgment of aid upon the premises & Verdict aforesaid to hear, for that the Court here
 thereof, not as yett &c.

All which said next Court to wit the seveneenth day of November and
 Done. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty came againe the parties aforesaid by their attorneys aforesaid
 and upon this all and singular the premises being seen and by the Justice fully understood &c.

Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid Ann^{or} doth recover against
 the said Charles Goson her Damages aforesaid to forty three pounds Seven Shillings and four pence ^{half penny} Sterling money
 by the Jurors aforesaid in firm aforesaid asessed as also Eight hundred & five ~~pounds~~
 of tobacco to the same Ann^{or} at her request for her Costs and Charges and by the Court her of Increase ad Judged
 which certain Damages in the whole do amounte to forty three pound Seven Shillings and four pence ^{half penny} Sterling money
 and Eight hundred and five ~~pounds of tobacco and 5 of Cents in money &c.~~

And afterwards the same day and year last mentioned Cometh before the Court the aforesaid Charles Goson in
 his proper person and as well for his Surety, as his Surety, pray that he by the Court here may be committed
 to the prison of the Shire of Somerset County by reason of the Judgment aforesaid that he should remain until he
 and the same Surety from his being bail and be discharged &c. Wherupon the same Charles present before the Court
 at the prayer of the aforesaid is committed to the prison of the Shire of Somerset County for the Damages and
 in firm aforesaid Recovered that he should remain until he the said Charles doth pay by John Dams Junr
 his deputy being present ^{before the Court} Change of a fine hundred and eighty &c. and the Surety aforesaid John Dams Junr
 of his obligation of bail and in that part made by the Court here is fully discharged &c.

John Stewart - Somerset / Command was Given to the Shire of Somerset County that he should

Mathew Dogan - State the said Mathew Dogan late of Somerset County Shipwright if he should be found in
 his bailly writ and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justice of

And the said John Stewart by Francis Allen his attorneys, declared against the said Mathew Dogan in

 Shipwright was attacked to answer unto John Stewart of a plea of the said upon the &c.

And wherupon the said John by Francis Allen his attorneys Complaind that whereas the said
 Mathew the Eight day of April and Done. Seven hundred and thirty at Somerset County of
 within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the said John in Sixteen pound, Seventeen Shillings and
 ten pence Curr. Money of Maryland it being as well for Sundry Goods, wares and Merchandises by the said John
 delivered as for Credits by him Given to Sundry persons as by aut. hereunto annexed may in Cop. appear
 and so being thereof indebted the said Mathew in Consideration thereof the day and year aforesaid at the
