Thereupon command is given to the Just. of Somerset County that immediately he cause to come here twelve by whom he who neither do to Inquire because as well of which said precept the said Just. to wit John Cornwall Gent. now honest this day to wit the Twentieth day of November and one thousand seven hundred and thirty comes and makes return that he hath served twelve as by his said precept he was Committed and now hereafterwards to wit the same day and year came the parties by their attorney aforesaid and the Jurors of that Jury thereunto Impannelled being called came to wit James Rownd, Samuel Dorman, Thomas Selby, Isaac Piper, John Webb, John Hooffington, Solomon Laboura, John Stockley, Peter Claywell, Francis Carter, Buffe Broughton, Hugh Nolle - who being duly sworn and sworn to say the truth in the premises upon their Oath do say that the said James Shibley did not assume upon himself in manner and form as the aforesaid Rebecca and John above against him have Complain'd

It is therefore considered that the aforesaid Rebecca and John Complainers of the said William Cornwallis take nothing by their writ and declaration as but be those of in wrong for their false Complain and that the said James Shibley goe hence without day

It is ordered that the aforesaid Henry Williams by Leon Galbraith pray that the aforesaid Joshua Ward may give Security for costs in case non-suit be obtained against him in a plea of trespass upon the Case by the said Joshua Ward against Henry Williams in Somerset County Court brought, which is by the Court granted. It is ordered that Thomas Bunting of Somerset County in manner aforesaid present before Court undertake for the said Joshua Ward that in case he be non-suit in the plea as or otherwise Legally said that the said Joshua Ward shall pay the Condemnation of the Court and all Costs accruing thereon to the said Henry Williams or that he and said Thomas Bunting will do the same for him
