firmly by these presents Sealed with our Seals and dated this 18. day of November anno Dom. 1730.

The Condition of the above Obligation is Such that whereas the Comptrolary Genl. hath transmitted unto this Court
the account of the Estate of Richard Ackworth decd. wherein it is found that there is balance due to the above-
said Richard Ackworth and Ann Opley the Sum of Sixty five pounds Eleven Shillings and four pence -

If therefore the abovesaid Charles Ackworth, Thomas Ackworth, James Hardy and John Huatt Nutton
or any or either of them, or any or either of their hoirs Executors or administrators do and shall well and truly
pay or cause to be paid unto the abovesaid Richard Ackworth and Ann Opley the abovesaid Sum of Sixty
five pounds Eleven Shillings and four pence when they shall attain to full age according to act of Parliament
in that behalf made and provided and the debt will be then the above Obligation to be void and of none -
