October 9th 1790 then came Alex^r McFarlane merchant before me the Subscriber one of his Lordships Justices of Peace for the County of Somerset and took his Oath on the holy Evangelist of Almighty God that he and within against Walter Jacobs is just & true & that however Received any part or parcel thereof nor any thing in Satisfaction for the Same more than what he has given & paid for to the

best of his knowledge. Sworn to the day & Year above before me - William Moughton
 Whereas upon the aforesaid Walter Jacobs in his own proper person appears and thereupon the said Walter Jacobs at the prayer of the aforesaid Alexander by his attorney aforesaid is adjudged to give Special bail to the action aforesaid
 Thereupon a certain Joseph M^r Carter of Somerset County Gent. present before me in his proper person undertakes for the said Walter Jacobs that if the said Alexander should recover Judgment in the plea aforesaid against the aforesaid Walter or that the said Walter shall be throni Conit that then he the said Walter shall pay the Exemption of the Court or tender his body to the Custody of the Sher^{iff} of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that he the said Joseph M^r Carter will do it for him &c

And the aforesaid Walter Jacobs in his proper person comes and defends the force and Injury when &c and says that he cannot gain say the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Alexander, nor but that he did a sum upon himself in manner and form as the aforesaid Alexander above against him hath complained, and as to the damage of the same Alexander by him by Quashon of the premises in that part sustained, the same Walter saith & confesseth that the aforesaid Alexander hath sustained damage by Quashon of the premises further than his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part appeared to five hundred and eighty four pounds of tobacco and not more and because the aforesaid Alexander denies not this but the same allegation confesseth to be true prays Judgment and those damages above confessed together with his costs and charges and to him adjudged &c

Therefore by Consent of the parties aforesaid it is considered that the aforesaid Alexander McFarlane Recover against the aforesaid Walter Jacobs his damages aforesaid to five hundred and eighty four pounds of tobacco by the same Walter in form aforesaid confessed as also two hundred & sixty nine pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges aforesaid to the same Alexander at his request by the Court here and Consent of the parties aforesaid Adjudged which certain damages with the whole do amount to eight hundred & fifty three pounds of tobacco and the aforesaid Walter in mercy &c

AND whereupon the same Christopher by Francis Allen his attorney saith that whereas the aforesaid Deverix the tenth day of November Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and twenty nine at Somerset County within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his Certain Writing Obligatory Confessed himselfe held unto the aforesaid Christopher the as^t Sum of five hundred and fifty pounds
