And the aforesaid Deveris Drigore in his own proper person appears and throughon the
said Deveris at the prayer of the Plaintiff by his attorney aforesaid is adjudged to give Special bail to &
action aforesaid, whereupon a certain Peter Baskett of Somerset County planter present now in Court
in his proper person undertakes for the said Deveris that if in case the said Christopher should recover
Judgment in the plea aforesaid against the aforesaid Deveris or that the said Deveris should be thrown
convict, that then the said Deveris shall pay the Exemnation of the Court throughon or tender
his body to the custody of the Sh^d of Somerset County in Satisfaction thereof or that he the said
Peter Baskett will do it for him &c -

And the aforesaid Deveris in his own proper person comes and defends the force
and Injury when he and says that he cannot pay the action aforesaid of the aforesaid D^e Christopher
nor but that the writing obligating aforesaid is Deed of the Same Deveris, nor but that he owes the
Same Christopher the aforesaid five hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco and six hundred and fifty
pounds of Beefe in manner and form as the aforesaid Christopher above against him hath declared, there-
upon the said Christopher prays Judgment for his debt aforesaid and his damages by reason of the detain-
ing of the Same Debt &c -

Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid Christopher
shall recover against the aforesaid Deveris Drigore five hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco and six hundred
and fifty pounds of Good Beefe his debt aforesaid and his damages by reason of the detaining of the Same
debt to two hundred & forty two pounds of tobacco to the Same Christopher of
his spent by the Court here adjudged and the aforesaid D^e in merrery &c -

Ordered by the Court that Mathew Dogan pay unto Cornelius Dickerson two hundred and seventy pounds
of tobacco, being due unto him for his attendance nine days as an Evidence on behalf of the said Mathew
against John Stewart he having made Oath to the Same &c -

Ordered by the Court that John Stewart pay unto William Broughton the Sum of ninety pounds of tobacco
it being due unto him for his attendance three days as an Evidence on behalf of the said John Stewart
against Mathew Dogan he having made Oath to the Same &c -

Ordered by the Court that Charles Ramsey pay unto Margaret Chapman two hundred & ten
pounds of tobacco being due unto her for her attendance seven days as an Evidence on behalf of the said
Charles Ramsey against Jones Reards he having made Oath to the Same &c -

Ordered by the Court that Jones Reards pay unto John Quorton the Sum of three hundred and sixty pounds
of tobacco it being due unto him for his attendance twelve days as an Evidence on behalf of the said Jones
Reards against Charles Ramsey he having made Oath to the Same &c -

Ordered by the Court that Charles Ramsey pay unto Thomas Morrey three hundred pounds of tobacco it
being due unto him for his attendance ten days as an Evidence on behalf of the said Charles Ramsey
against
