James Donelson } Command was given to the Shd. of Somerset County that he should take George Martin Esq. of Somerset County merchant if he should be found in his Baylywick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November then next to answer unto James Donelson of plea of trespass upon the Case &c. and that Whosoever should not fail &c.
And the said James Donelson by Leonie Gale his attorney complains against the said Geo. Martin in the plea aforesaid as follows to wit -
Somerset p. George Martin Esq. of Somerset County Merchant was attacked to - answer unto James Donelson of plea of trespass upon the Case &c.

And whereupon the same James Donelson by Leonie Gale his attorney complains that whereas the aforesaid George Martin the twenty sixth day of December One thousand Seven hundred and twenty nine at Somerset County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court using trade and Commerce according to the Custom of merchants and others of this the Province of Maryland & the City of London of old used made & drew his Second Bill of Exchange with his proper hand Subscribed bearing Date the day & year aforesaid To a certain John Peale Merchant in London in the Kingdom of England Videlicet & negotiating Directed and by the said Bill Requested the said John Peale at thirty days sight thereof his first nor third of the same tenor and date paid to pay unto the same James Donelson or his order Seventy three pounds Sterling for Value Recd. of which said Bill the said John Peale afterwards to wit the thirteenth day of March and Doud One thousand Seven hundred and twenty nine at London Videlicet in Somerset County aforesaid within the aforesaid Jurisdiction had notice and then and there was requested to pay the said sum of seventy three pounds Sterling to the order of the same James Donelson and the same James Donelson in fact saith that the aforesaid John Peale at thirty days sight of the aforesaid Second Bill of Exchange the aforesaid sum of Seventy three pounds Sterling to him the same James -
