

His Lordship Somerset & The Jurors for the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of this Province that now John Lee Esq<sup>r</sup> is for the body of Somerset County upon their Oath do present that John Lee Esq<sup>r</sup> late of Somerset County Taylor the tenth day of March One Thousand Seven hundred and twenty Nine at Somerset County within the Jurisdiction of this Court with force & arms did committe凶詐 with a certain Elizabeth Twigle and the said Eliz<sup>r</sup> Twigle and others equally did know against the peace of the Lord Proprietary his Good Rule and Government and also against the form of the law of a penalty in this Case made and provided. *L Galfrid Brody*

On the back side of the foregoing bill of Indictment it was Endorsed videlicet *Bella Vera: Quia Rebellis*

Thereupon command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said John Lee Esq<sup>r</sup> if he to answer her and afterwards now present to will the Sixteenth day of March and One Thousand Seven hundred and twenty one to the aforesaid John Lee in his proper person and pray alerning of the Indictment aforesaid and he hath it, and being asked how he would acquit himself of the premises aforesaid, says that he is not guilty thereof, and of this he putteth himself upon the Country and Leon Gale Esq<sup>r</sup> his Lordships attorney who for his said Lordship in that part followeth Likewise thereto

Thereupon command is given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that immediately he cause to come here before him by whom he who neither do to recouire him because as well as of which present the said Sheriff will John Lee make good now present to will the same day and year last mentioned makes return that he hath here ready to give as by his said present he was commanded her and the Jurors of that Jury wherein Impannelled being called unto will, James Round, Wm Jones, Thomas Leyley, Isaac Marsden Edward Franklin, John Holland, John Townsend, William Wright, Thomas Collins, Daniel Boyce, Angelo Alkinson, and John Houghington who being duly elected byed and sworn to say the truth of the premises, upon their Oath do say that the aforesaid John Lee is not guilty of the premises whereofold stande Indictable.

Therefore it is Considered that the aforesaid John Lee of the premises aforesaid be quiet and go hence without day her wherupon it is ordered that the aforesaid John Lee give power to pay the several Officers mentioned by means of the premises aforesaid, therupon John Dennis Esq<sup>r</sup> of Somerset County gentleman and undertaker for the said John Lee to pay the several Officers for due by occasion of the premises aforesaid.

in the County aforesaid for an assault and Battery against Samuel Newell constable of Balle:

Thereupon command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said Thomas Collins if he to answer her and afterwards in the same Court came the said Thomas Collins in his proper person and therupon the said Thomas Collins is justly demanded how he would acquit himself of the premises aforesaid, says that aforesaid he is guilty thereof and putteth himself in "mercy of his said Lordship" thereto

Therefore it is Considered that the aforesaid Thomas Collins pay unto his said Lordship one hundred pounds of tobacco for his fine by occasion of the premises upon him imposed and that the same money be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid
