Jury did mark a Line tree at w^{ch} point of Land w^{ch} w^{ch} above said Bishop - declared to and further saith not - The same day also Richard Tully Dist^r and for Evidence came Rob^t Richardson son of Charles Richardson deceased aged about twenty four years and being sworn on the holy Evangelist of almighty god with that his father Charles Richardson told him that at that point high Land - were the said Quinton Bratton and Thomas Durnall aged and did fix up a Cedar post that there stood a Line tree of his Land and that Cap^t Howell cut it down for a Shaft to his Mine and further saith not - also Charles Richardson an Evidence aged about twenty four years being sworn to w^{ch} as? Charles and being sworn on w^{ch} holy Evangelist of almighty god with that on w^{ch} point of high Land where w^{ch} Cedar post - stand right against a Beaver dam his father Charles Richardson told him that there stood a Line tree of his Land and further with not - The same day J^o Seafeld Dist^r pleaded that he had another Evidence as viz: John League who was very much indisposed and not able to come to give his Evidence therefore on the twenty third day of w^{ch} Month of December came John League an Evidence aged about twenty years and being sworn on the holy Evangelist of almighty god saith that by the North side of w^{ch} Great Beaver Dam below the high Point of Land on Richardson side and about twenty one paces up w^{ch} dam from where John Bishop - said w^{ch} Jury marked a tree w^{ch} Depoent saith that about twenty two years past there was a Juny Mark - a tree there in order to run w^{ch} Line from Bratton from thence and Mr W^{ch} Whillington was then present and the Line from thence w^{ch} Depoent was about to buy that Land of Bratton before Bratton bought it and found it so narrow that he did not care to purchase it and further saith that about one hundred yards higher up w^{ch} dam his Master Richardson told him that w^{ch} old Line run from thence with a line of Marked - trees up to the head to a Marked Huray and that his son w^{ch} Richardson told him he knew w^{ch} Line to be his and further with not that his Master Richardson told him that w^{ch} North side of that great Beaver dam on w^{ch} bank or point of Land 2^d paces above where Bishop declared to there they might find his logs for that was his Land w^{ch} Depoent further saith w^{ch} at w^{ch} upon w^{ch} Line above mentioned being about one hundred yards above w^{ch} Great Beaver Dam he could see w^{ch} Cedars on w^{ch} South side w^{ch} Creek and his Master Robert Richardson and his son William both told him that their Land came from those Cedars to w^{ch} point above w^{ch} Old Beaver Dam it being above one hundred yards above w^{ch} Beaver Dam and further with not - Also w^{ch} Boaler w^{ch} same day came as an Evidence aged forty two and being sworn on the Holy Evangelist of almighty god saith that about twenty three years ago there was Juny held as he remembers in order to settle a boundary between James Bratton and Smith and that at that point on w^{ch} North side of w^{ch} dam where Bishop and Dennis Dairied to that there or there about they settled a Bound^r for thence - beginning of w^{ch} Line and further saith not - Also w^{ch} Whillington an Evidence aged about forty seven and being sworn on w^{ch} holy Evangelist of almighty god saith that where w^{ch} above said Juny settled w^{ch} Bound^r that the wife of old Robert Richardson who was w^{ch} owner of Mount Ephraim w^{ch} she told this Depoent w^{ch} her husband told her as he remembers that there or there a way there line did run and that he was desired to set his Log of w^{ch} said Juny settled and to run w^{ch} Courses of the patent from thence and accordingly he did w^{ch} Richardson's wife gave w^{ch} above words in Evidence to the said Juny and the said Depoent also run from a tree at the head of the Land which is tree Robert Dny told them was the End of the Line run from where w^{ch} Juny settled but reversing w^{ch} Courses of the Patent tree it came down thro James Bratton's Plantation and Henry upon which w^{ch} Juny concluded that the Line should begin to run from where w^{ch} Richardson wife gave Evidence to and further with not - as witness our hands this Seventh day of March and Dou^t 1730
