 to the best of his knowledge w^s Jury d^d mark a Line tree at w^s point of Land w^s above said Bishop -
 declared to and further saith not - The same day also Richard Tull Dft and for Evidence came Robert
 Richardson son of Charles Richardson deceased aged about Twenty four years and being sworn on w^s holy
 Evangelist of Almighty god saith that his Father Charles Richardson told him that at that point high Land
 were the said Quinton Bratt and Thomas Durnall aged and did for up a cedar post that there stood a Line tree
 of his Land and that Cap. Howell cut it down for a Shaft to his Mill and further saith not
 also Charles Richardson an Evidence aged about Twenty four years being sworn on w^s af^r Charles and being
 sworn on w^s holy Evangelist of Almighty god saith that on w^s point of high Land where w^s Cedar post -
 stand right against a Beaver dam his father Charles Richardson told him that there stood a Line tree of
 his Land and further saith not - The same day Jos^e Peaford Dft pleaded that he had another Evidence to w^s
 John League who was very stale indisposed and not able to come to give his Evidence therefore on the twenty
 third day of M^r Month of December came John League an Evidence aged about Twenty years and being sworn
 on the Holy Evangelist of Almighty god saith that by the North side of w^s Greatest Beaver Dam below
 the high Point of Land on Richardson's side and about twenty one pace up w^s dam from whence John Bishop
 said w^s Jury marked a tree w^s Depoent saith that about twenty odd years past there was a Tree mark -
 a tree here in order to run w^s Line for Brattou from hence and Mr. W^m Wellington was then present & ran
 the Line from hence w^s Depoent was about to cut that Land of Brattou before Brattou bought it and
 found it so narrow that he did not care to purchase it and further saith that about one hundred yard higher
 up w^s dam his Master Richardson told him that w^s old line run from hence with a line of marked
 trees up to the head to a marked Hilary and that his son w^s Richardson told him he knew w^s Line to be his and further saith that his Master Richardson told him that on w^s North side of that great
 Beaver Dam on w^s back or point of Land 21 acres above where Bishop declared to have they might fed
 his hogs for that was his Land w^s Depoent further saith w^s at w^s up w^s old line above mentioned being about
 one hundred yards above w^s Great Beaver Dam he could see w^s Cedar on w^s South side w^s Creek and his Master
 Robert Richardson and his son William both told him that their land came from those Cedars to w^s
 point above w^s old Beaver Dam it being above one hundred yards above w^s Beaver Dam and further saith
 not - Also W^m Brattou w^s same day came as an Evidence aged forty two and being sworn on the Holy
 Evangelist of Almighty god saith that about Twenty three years ago there was Jury held as he remembers in
 order to settle a boundary between James Brattou and Smith and that at that point on w^s North side of w^s
 dam where Bishop and Dennis Dallard to that place or thereabouts they settled a Bound^r for their
 beginning of w^s Line and further saith not - Also W^m Wellington an Evidence aged about forty
 seven and being sworn on w^s holy Evangelist of Almighty god saith that where w^s above said Jury settled
 w^s Boundary that the wife of old Robert Richardson who was w^s owner of Mount Ephraim w^s she told
 his Depoent w^s her husband told her as he remembers that there or there a way there line did run and that he
 was desired to set his course of what he said Jury settled and to run w^s Courses of the paleant from thence and
 accordingly he did w^s Richardson's wife gave w^s above words in Evidence to the said Jury and her said
 Depoent also run from a tree at the head of the Land while w^s tree Robert Penny told them was the
 end of the Line run from where w^s Jury settled but running w^s Courses of the Paleant from thence it came
 down to James Brattou, Plaintiff and Henry upon which w^s Jury concluded that the Line should
 begin to run from where w^s Richardson's wife gave Evidence to and further saith not
