The Condition of the above Recognizance is Such that if the above bounden John Riggini do and shall make his personall appearance before the Justice of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be hold at dividing Court the third Tuesday of June next, to answer unto his Lordship concerning such matters and things as shall be then and there objected against him on his Lordship's behalf, and to stand and abide the judgment of the Court thereupon, and do not depart the Court with License thereof and in the mean time to be of the good behaviour to all his Lordship's Good people and more Especially towards the said Samuel Riggini than the above Recognizance to be void and of None Effect otherwise &c

Thereupon Command was Given to the Just. of Somerset County that he should take the said Rachell Kull if he to answer &c. and afterwards in the same Court came the said Rachell Kull in her proper person, and being Instantly demanded how she would acquit herself of the premises afo, says that she is Guilty hereof & makes Oath that a certain Patrick Connolly is the begetter of the Child she stands presented for and is willing to pay her fine for the same afo. Therefore it is Considered that the aforesaid Rachell Kull pay to his Lordship the said Proprietary thirty Shillings for her fine by Quasion of the premises upon her Impored, and that the said Rachell be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid, and further it is ordered by the Court that the afo Rachell Give Security for the payment of the Several Officers their fees due by Quasion of the premises afo, thereupon a certain John White of Rowenoke present before Court undertakes for the said Rachell to pay the Several Officers fees due by Quasion of the premises afo &c
