Thereupon Command was Given to the Sher: of Somerset County that he should take the said

 said Sher: to wit John Burnall Gent now here at this day to wit the Same day and Year Last mentioned  
 cometh the said Sher: and maketh Return that he hath here ready to chuse he: or by his said precept he  
 was Commanded, and now hereafterwards to wit the Same day Year afo: Cometh as well the afo:  
 Lewin Gale Esq: who for his said Lordship in this behalfe prosecutes as the afo: Phillip Selby in his pro -  
 : per person, and the Jurors of that Jury therein Impannelled being called Likewise came to wit Wm:  
 Jones, Thomas Rayley, Isaac Marshale, Edward franklin, John Holland, John Townsend, Wm Wright  
 Thomas Collier, Daniel Boyce, Angello Alkison, John Hoofington, and Phillip Quinton. who being  
 duly Oathed hys and sworn to say the truth in the premises upon their Oath do say that the said Phillip  
 Selby is not Guilty of the premises in manner and form above suggested &c --- whereas the  
 premises by the Court here being seen read and fully understood &c
