:per person, and hath alsoing of the Information aforesaid, and being therupon Justly demanded how
he would acquit himself of the premises aforesaid, above upon him imposed, Say that he is not thereof
Guilty and of this he puts himself upon the Country and Lewin Gale Esq: who for his said Lordship in this
behalf presents Likewise aforesaid

Thereupon command is given to the Sheriff of Somersel County that I immediately to cause to come
here before me by whom he who neither he to recognize me because as well he of which said present the
said Sheriff to wit John Burnside Gent now heret this day to wit the same day and year last mentioned
comes to the said Sheriff and makest return that he hath here ready to serve me as by his said present he
was commanded, and now hereafterwards to wit the same day year and Comell as well the aforesaid
Lewin Gale Esq: who for his said Lordship in this behalf presents as his aforesaid Phillip Selby in his pro
:per person, and the Jurors of that Jury herein impannelled being called likewise came to wit Wm.
Jones, Thomas Rayley, Isaac Marshall, Edward Franklin, John Holland, John Townsend, Wm Wright
Thomas Rollins, Daniel Boyce, Angelo Alderson, John Hoofington, and Phillip Quinton. who being
duly elected hys and sworn to say the truth in the premises upon their Oath do say that the said Phillip
Selby is not guilty off the premises in manner and form above supposed &c — whereupon the
premises by the Court here being seen read and fully understood
