And whereupon the aforesaid Heber Whittingham Garrisoner of the aforesaid George Martin appears in his own
proper person and says that he cannot pay but that he hath of the Rights and Credits of the Said
George Martin in his hands to the value of nearly five thousand Seven hundred pounds of tobacco, nor can he
pay but that the same ought to be condemned in his hands for the use of the Said James Donelson as of the
Rights and Credits of the Said George Martin which the Said party doth not pay -

Whereupon the Said James Donelson by his attorney as prays that upon giving security according to act of
Assembly in such case made and provided, the aforesaid sum of twenty five thousand Seven hundred pounds
of tobacco as of the Rights and Credits of the Said George Martin, so aforesaid purposed by the
aforesaid Heber Whittingham, may be condemned in his hands of the Said Heber Whittingham towards -
Satisfying of the Said James Donelson of the aforesaid Eighty four pounds three Shillings and Eight pence
Sterling and Seventeen hundred pounds of tobacco,

Whereupon after the John Caldwell of Somerset County Gent present here
in Court in his proper person undertakes for the Said James Donelson, according to act of Assembly
that if in case the Said George Martin do appear at any time within a year and day, and make
all or any part of the Said James Donelson claim, against him, to be satisfied, or otherwise to be
indeed before laying of the attachment aforesaid, that then he the Said James Donelson shall
make Restitution unto him the Said George Martin, of all or such part thereof, shall be so
made appear to be indeed due or that he the said John Caldwell will do it for him Yes -

Therefore it is considered by the Justices, that the aforesaid sum of nearly five thousand Seven
hundred pounds of tobacco so aforesaid and purposed be condemned in the hands of the aforesaid Heber
Whittingham as of the Rights and Credits of the aforesaid George Martin, towards Satisfying unto
the aforesaid James Donelson as well the sum of Eighty four pounds Three Shillings and Eight pence
Sterling and Seventeen hundred pounds of tobacco as also all the rest accruing upon the worth of above
ment aforesaid that the Said James Donelson have thereof his Execution against the Said Heber -
Whittingham according to act of Assembly Es
