

I. P. Robert Warren — { memorandum of the p[ro]fess by James Shirley his attorney Sued out his Lordship's writ of attachment ag<sup>t</sup>.  
 David Olford Esq<sup>r</sup> } Humphrey Hughe — the deft the tenour whereof followeth in these words vizt.

Somerset County to Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Province of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the Sher. of Somerset County Greeting we command you that you attack any the Goods and Chattels Rights or Credits of Humphrey Hughe Late of Somerset County planter if they shall be found in your County to the value of Six hundred pounds of tobacco and when you have the same attacked or any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before Our Justices of Our County Court of Somerset to be held at Newington Green the third Tuesday of March next then and there to be condemned according to Law to and for the use of aforesaid Robert Warren unless the said Humphrey by himself or his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Robert Warren in open Court upon the same according to Law and that by Gods and Law full man of your bailywick you make known unto his person or persons in whose hands you make the same — attachment that he she or they he and appear before the Justice of Our County Court to be held as aforesaid to show cause if any he she or they have why the same Good Chattels Rights or Credits so attacked in his hands or their hands ought not to be condemned and executed accordingly and made according to the form of the act of Assembly in such case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and like you shall execute — this will that you make known unto our said Justices at the day & place of resaid and have you them and here his will witness Wm Blaund Gent<sup>r</sup> One of Our Justices of Our said Court the twenty fourth day of November in the sixteenth year of Our Saviour. And Dowd One thousand Seven hundred & Thirtynine

At which said third Tuesday of March to wit the Sixteenth day of the same month being the day of the return of a said Writ Quo<sup>r</sup> Dicte. One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety four Ag<sup>t</sup> the said Robert Warren by his attorney aforesaid and the Sher. of Somerset County to whom the foregoing Writ was directed Likewise came and makes return therof to the Court had endor<sup>d</sup> vizt — To the Worshipful Justice within mentioned I certify that I have attacked in the hand of David Olford one hundred and Ninety pounds of tobacco aforesaid Right, and Credits of the within named Humphrey Hughe and further I certify that by Charles Brackliffe & Isaac Marshall good and lawfull men of my Bailywick I have made known unto the said David Olford that he be and appear at that time and place within contained to show & as by the within present I am commanded —

John Curwall Sher.

Whereupon the aforesaid Robert Warren by his attorney prays that the sum of one hundred and Ninety pounds of tobacco so as aforesaid attacked in the hands of the aforesaid David Olford as of the Rights and Credits of the said Humphrey Hughe may be condemned in the hands of the said David Olford to — wads satisfying unto the said Robert Warren his damages and costs and at last accounting upon the writ of — wads satisfying unto the said David Olford altho' solemnly casted away, not but makes default of attachment aforesaid Whereupon the aforesaid David Olford altho' solemnly casted away, not but makes default of attachment aforesaid

Therefore it is considered by the Court that the aforesaid sum of one hundred and Ninety pounds of tobacco so as aforesaid attacked be condemned in the hands of the aforesaid David Olford aforesaid of the Rights and Credits of the said Humphrey Hughe towards satisfying unto the said Robert Warren his damages and costs and costs accounting upon the writ of attachment aforesaid and that the aforesaid Humphrey Hughe pay execution against the said David Olford according to act of Assembly &c.

I. P. John Tread — This Banch action of trespass upon the land &c wherein the Sher. of Somerset County to whom the aforesaid Damages due — The writ in this same action was directed to him and makes return therof to the Court had endorsed vizt — Recd Corpos of John Curwall Sher.

Whereupon the said Dominic Danvers Jus<sup>r</sup> appears and prayeth that the said John Tread may give account for costs in this cause to be obtained against him in the plea aforesaid which is by the Court granted Whereupon John Tread of Somerset County Esq<sup>r</sup> general Court in his presence present
